

What is Grace Christian Preschool's Clubhouse Summer Camp?

We offer ten weeks of fun themed camps during the summer! Campers will enjoy physical activities, games, crafts, music, stories, and more!

GCS Clubhouse Summer Camp is open to current, incoming and alumni students.

Curriculum: Each camp will have a theme that is enhanced by art projects, outdoor and indoor activities, music, Bible stories, and more!

Chapel: We will have chapel on Tuesdays and Wednesday of each week. In chapel, we will present a Bible story and learn Bible verses. We will also focus on a special Missions Project.- The Jessie Rees Foundation/NEGU and help provide money for "Joy Jars". Chapel will be presented in a Zoom format.

Special Activities: Prior to each camp, registered families will receive a newsletter by email. This newsletter will highlight specific activities we will be doing each day and describe anything you need to bring (i.e. Crazy Hair Day, bring your favorite stuffed animal, etc.).

Water Play Days: Water play days are scheduled for EVERY FRIDAY of each camp. This year, we will modify our Water Days to include sprinklers on the grass and we will wet the sand down to make sand castles. We will continue to monitor current guidelines during the summer and make necessary adjustments to our program. Campers will definitely have the opportunity to get wet! We request that you send a towel (make sure your child's name is on it). Don't forget to apply sunscreen before arriving to camp. *Don't forget "swimmer" type pull-ups on these days, if applicable.

Camp Rules: HAVE FUN and remember to apply sunscreen before coming to camp each day. Closed toe shoes are required to attend the camps. Send your child to camp with a tote bag each day, change of clothes, and extra pull-ups if applicable.

Staff: Our preschool teachers and staff run our camps exclusively! This is a great opportunity for our teachers to get to know your child before school begins in the fall and for your child to get to know us and the campus. This helps to make the first days of school in September a much easier transition.
